## NEED A VACATION??

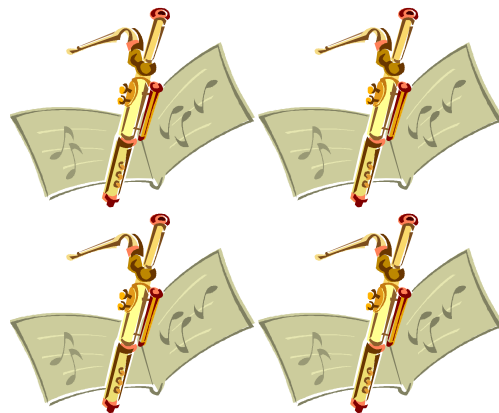

### Momentum Builds for “COME SAILING SUNDAYS”!

June 18<sup>th</sup> saw the third monthly “Come Sailing Sunday”, and the momentum is really building. More than 20 folk got to ride out into the harbor during the course of the day, a great mix of experienced sailors, first-timers, club members, guests and visitors.

And that is what the “Come Sailing Sundays” are all about.

The role of Sailing Officer has been created by the Instruction Committee with Board approval to provide an experienced individual responsible for hosted sailing activities on Come Sailing Sundays. On those days the club’s newly established and ever-growing fleet of CAL20s, normally available to any qualified member to sail at will, is placed under the Sailing Officer’s control to ensure that all members, guests or visitors, especially those to whom sailing is a new experience, can take a spin with an experienced skipper and discover the delights of being afloat under sail.

The CAL20 has proven an ideal platform for complete novices to enjoy a non-intimidating, sociable, dry-foot introduction to sailing. Those familiar with boats but not cleared on the CAL20 can take the helm and relax with a beverage on a sunny day, or may seek to have their skills sharpened as a step towards qualifying. And of course qualified members get the thrill of giving other people a good time. It’s all about having whatever kind of sailing fun you want to.

Usually the Sailing Officer will spend the day ashore, making the first boat ready, then, as expectant folk and qualified sailors show up during the day, coordinating passengers, skippers and boats, ensuring waivers are signed, setting expectations and generally looking cool talking on VHF. “Neal, Neal, Neal, time to switch, we’ve got 3 more victims for your tall tales”. If everything is running smoothly ashore, or there are no other qualified skippers, the S.O. may skipper a boat, relying on the day’s Watch Officer to signal the

arrival of more takers. Gosh, we’re such a flexible organization.

We are very excited about how many HMBYC folk and friends are suddenly getting out on the water. For many participants this is their first season afloat after many spent ashore watching as others would dressed up like ninja warriors, fall over in their dinghies, struggle wetly back to shore and heave hulls up and down the slip, the onlookers knowing quite clearly that was not *THEIR* idea of fun. We see “Come Sailing Sundays” and the CAL20 fleet as powerful, new catalysts for growth both on the water and in the clubhouse.

The next “Come Sailing Sunday” is on July 23<sup>rd</sup> and they are scheduled through October, weather permitting. We may even add bonus Sundays in between the ‘official’ monthly dates as demand and opportunity presents itself – keep an eye out for them by reading your weekly TellTales email!

So spread the word, come down on July 23<sup>rd</sup>, bring your friends, and if you are qualified for a CAL20 help us by skippering one.
