BUILDING EXPANSION UPDATE

FINANCING:

It has been confirmed that HMBYC can qualify for a loan which would cover most or all of the building cost, depending on the final building details. This means that individual contributions will still be pursued to help reduce interest costs, but they are not critical to finance the construction. Additionally, we have two of three construction bids in house which confirm that the building cost is within the club's borrowing range depending on the final building details.

BUILDING TIMELINE:


A new loan will take at least two months to organize and sign. The construction would extend over a 12-month period, but can be done faster or stretched out 24 months. The building committee still needs to resolve the timing after the builder is selected. The start of the project would be the autumn of 2007 at the earliest or January 2008 at the latest.

QUARTET CONCERT**

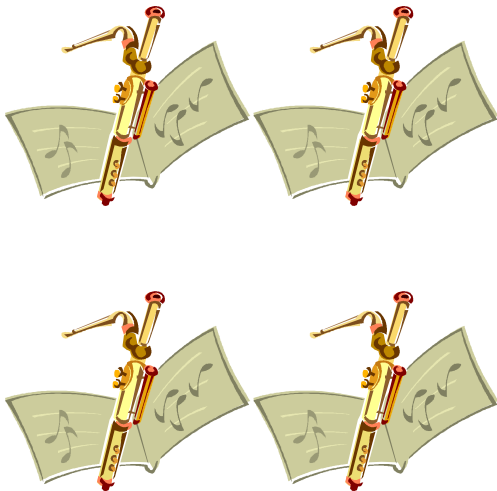
