**Claire D. Miller, M.D.**

Claire Miller (nee Borkert), a long-time member of HMBYC and prominent Bay Area AIDS physician, died peacefully in her home, on June 24, from cancer. Claire was a friend and mentor to many on the Coastside and elsewhere. A gifted doctor, she devoted her professional life to the service of others as an Internal Medicine physician. For the last 18 years, she served as the medical co-director of the East Bay AIDS Center (EBAC) at Alta Bates Summit Medical Center. Her patients and colleagues adored her.

Claire exuded southern charm. She had a way of making whomever she was talking to feel like they had her undivided attention. She was skillful and talented without being boastful. She enjoyed kayaking, hiking and socializing with her friends at the Yacht Club. Claire was an avid craftsperson who relished sharing her adventures in the arts; from mosaics to knitting, wirework to stained glass and especially the jewelry she made using her beautiful

glass beads. She loved gardening, books on tape, and her cats Elvis and Iggy.

Claire was an accomplished sailor with both coastal and offshore certifications. She loved a good run whether it was between islands in the BVIs or a return from Angel Island to her home berth in Alameda or later in South Beach. Claire had a perfect ocean-going race record; one win (New Boreas '04) in one race. She helped start the Women's Sailing program at HMBYC and was a mainstay of support for fundraising; organizing all of the recent Fall Fundraiser Auctions as well as the Women's Sail Scholarship Benefit Auction earlier this year.

Claire will be missed greatly by her friends, family and especially by her husband Larry. A memorial celebration is scheduled for July 11<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 to 4:00 PM at the Hyatt Regency Embarcadero (Garden Room) San Francisco. Please gather with us. We are offering training classes on First Aid, CPR, and use of this

AED machine. Participants learn to recognize and respond to emergencies. Develop confidence that comes with knowing what to do. You can make a difference, this is a skill everyone should have. STRONG COFFEE and SNACKS will be served! Adult CPR/AED/First Aid covers adult CPR, use of an AED, choking, heart attack, stroke, cardiac arrest, and the cardiac chain of survival. The First Aid course covers patient assessment, bleeding control, shock management, musculoskeletal injuries, head/spine injuries, diabetic emergencies, seizures, environmental emergencies, poisonings, burns, drowning, hypothermia. The material is presented in both lecture and video format, and there will be plenty of hands on skills practice. Upon successful completion of the course the student will receive a two-year CPR/AED/First Aid certification card.
