NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority for this event is the Half Moon Bay Yacht Club.
- 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 The Coronado 15 class will, in addition to the NOR, RRS and Sailing Instructions, be subject to the Coronado 15 Association Class Rules.
- 1.4 While racing and on deck, all competitors shall wear personal floatation devices. This changes RRS 40.
- 1.5 RRS 25 Signal Starting System will use a horn for all sound signals.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Laser, Coronado 15 and Cal20 classes.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached entry form and sending it, together with the required fee to HMBYC Vice Commodore's Cup HMBYC, PO Box 52, El Granada, CA 94018 by xx September 2010.
- 2.3 Late entries will be accepted on 26 September 2009 prior to the Sailor's Meeting.
- 2.4 Fleets must have at least three boats registered to qualify for a class start, this number may be modified at the discretion of the Race Committee.

3.0 FEES

- 3.1 Entry fee is \$35 for crewed classes (Coronado 15 and Cal20) and \$20 for single-handed classes (Laser).

4.0 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Check-In will be Saturday, 25 September 2010 from 0900 hours to 1000 hours.
- 4.2 Racing will be held on Saturday, 25 September 2010, for all classes and & Sunday, 26 September 2010, for the Laser and C15 classes.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race on Saturday is 1100 hours. The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race on Sunday is 1000 hours. A Sailors' Meeting will be held at 1000 hours on Saturday, 26 September 2010, on the HMBYC patio.
- 4.4 On Saturday, 25 September 2010, six races are planned with a lunch break. No race will be started after 1300 hours on Sunday, 26 September 2010.

5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions and NOR will be available at Half Moon Bay Yacht Club at the check-in before the Sailors' Meeting and online.

6.0 RACING AREA

6.1 The intended race area will be set within the Pillar Point Harbor utilizing inflatable and fixed marks.

7.0 SCORING

7.1 One race shall constitute a series.

7.2 For the Cal20 class six races on Saturday are scheduled in the series, all of which will count towards a boat's final score. For the Coronado 15 and Laser classes, ten races are scheduled in the series with six on Saturday and four on Sunday, all of which will count towards a boat's final score. No race will be started after 1300 hours on Sunday 27 September.

8.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
