BEGINNING LASER SAILING

April 2-9, 9am to 1pm, \$65- HMBYC will be hosting an introduction to Laser sailing for adult members. We will cover rigging the Laser, basic sailing skills (including tacking, gybing and self-rescue), and Club policies for use and storage of the Club-owned Lasers. The class will have a small class-room component, but primary will take place on the water. Participants must have a wetsuit and personal flotation device (PFD). A towel and change of dry clothes is strongly advised as every student will be required to practice capsize and self-rescue in each session.

Charlie Quest sends this message from his mountain climbing adventure in Nepal:

We are in Namche Bazar at 11,300 feet. It rained yesterday during our biggest climb of 2,600 feet up and 800 feet down. Spectacular suspension bridges. It's a lot harder to hike up a hill at 10,000 feet than to Hike Montara Mountain. Today it dawned clear and we are surrounded by rugged, snow-covered peaks. We hiked to a place where we got our first view of Mt. Everest. On Monday, April 4, we will arrive at Everest Base Camp at 17,600 feet, then head back down. On Friday, April 8, we arrive at Lukla, 9,200 feet. A small plane will take us back to Kathmandu and we are scheduled to get home on April 11.
