All members have access to the Club's Bar Room, Lanai, and picnic tables at all times. However, when a MEMBER RENTAL of the Event Center appears on the Club calendar, common courtesy should apply, including:

- ◆ Please keep children, dogs, sand and clutter out of the Event Center during a MEMBER RENTAL occasion.
- ◆ If toilets and showers in the Event Center are needed, please go around the exterior of the building and enter from the rear of the building rather than track through a member's private event in the Event Center.
- ◆ Please park diagonally rather than parallel to the fence on Vassar Street. This allows for 5 or 6 cars to park rather than just a couple of cars in the same space.

HMBYC Member Rental Fees -- Terms and Conditions EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2013

Event Center -- \leq 50 or less guests \$200

Bartender (5 hour minimum) \$100 (+ \$25 per hour beyond minimum)

Janitorial (5 hour minimum) \$100 (+ \$20 per hour beyond minimum)

Event Center -- 50-100 guests \$300

2 Bartenders (5 hour minimum) \$200 (+ \$25 @ per hour beyond minimum) 2 Janitorial (5 hour minimum) \$200 (+ \$20 @ per hour beyond minimum)

Event Center -- 100 or more guests \$500 (at Rental Manager's discretion) 2 Bartenders (5 hour minimum) \$200 (+ \$25 @ per hour beyond minimum) 2 Janitorial (5 hour minimum) \$200 (+ \$20 @ per hour beyond minimum)

AudioVisual Fee \$50

(Sound system, PA system, high-lumen computer projector, flat screen TV, screen)
To be set up prior to event and stowed properly and securely after event by a qualified AV Volunteer Member)

NO FRIDAY EVENING RENTALS FOR PARTIES OF 50 OR MORE GUESTS.

A FRIDAY RENTAL *may* be considered if less than 50 guests are confined to the Event Center with a tended bar in the Event Center.

SATURDAY RENTAL HOURS Noon – 10:00 pm

Be sure to have your event over with and cleaned up **NO LATER THAN 10:00 p.m.** when the Watch Officer will be ready to close and secure the Club's facilities, and the Bartender and Janitorial will have fulfilled their 5-hour commitment to the event. A qualified Watch Officer (other than the Member Renter/Event Captain) must be present for the duration of the event.

SUNDAY RENTAL HOURS Noon – 7:00 p.m.

Be sure to have your event over with and cleaned up **NO LATER THAN 7:00 p.m.** when the Watch Officer will be ready to close and secure the Club's facilities, and the Bartender and Janitorial will have fulfilled their 5-hour commitment to the event. A qualified Watch Officer (other than the Member Renter/Event Captain) must be present for the duration of the event.

WEEKDAY RENTAL HOURS: Dependent upon occasion & availability at the Rental Manager's discretion.

Linens, China, Silverware, S&P, Water Pitchers, Bar Glasses, etc.

Dependent upon occasion and availability at the Rental Manager's discretion. Member /Renters are encouraged to provide their own paper and plastic ware for their event.

HMBYC LICENSED BEVERAGE POLICY (Beer, Wine and Liquor)

- HMBYC adheres to ABC regulations regarding the Club's Liquor License. All licensed beverages must be purchased through the HMBYC bar and consumed on Club property.
- SALE TO A MINOR: "Every person who sells, furnishes, gives, or causes to be sold, furnished or given away, any alcoholic beverage to any person under the age of 21 years is guilty of a misdemeanor." Said person will be cited and can be personally responsible for \$1000 fine.

The Member/Renter of HMBYC Event Center may have alcoholic beverages served to adult guests wearing name tags in two ways, as long as all alcohol is purchased through HMBYC per ABC regulations:

- **No Host Bar:** Guests purchase their own beverages with cash or credit card as non-members.
- **Hosted Bar:** Member/Renter provides the bartender with a credit card (Visa, Mastercard)to be used for guests beverage purchases and settles the account at the end of the Watch.

MEMBER RENTAL/EVENT RESPONSIBILITIES

The Member/Renter is the Event Captain on behalf of HMBYC and is responsible for:

- A list of attendees on the day of the event so it can be added to the sign-in register. Event-specific nametags are recommended for all adult guests.
- The behavior and conduct of their guests at all times on HMBYC property.
- The adult supervision of minors at the event at all times: Event Center, Lanai, Beach Tiki Hut.
- Being present from start to finish of the event.
- Fundraising events other than for the benefit for HMBYC are **NOT** allowed on Club property.
- Ensuring that no outside alcoholic beverages are brought onto and/or consumed at HMBYC.
- Ensuring that HMBYC's zero-tolerance policy regarding violence and illegal drugs is enforced.
- Ensuring that the event ends at an appropriate time or at the Watch Officer's request.
- As Event Captain, the Renting member is responsible for leaving the Event Center clean and secure, removing all trash, decorations and personal items *immediately* following the event.




