Sea Level Rise In San Mateo County

January 15 • 6:00 - 7:00 pm at Half Moon Bay Yacht Club

San Mateo County is one of the most vulnerable regions of the Bay Area to the problem of rising sea levels from climate change. As a result, a multi-stakeholder working group spearheaded by Supervisor Dave Pine has been established to develop a vulnerability assessment for the entire county. Please join county staff and others on Friday, January 15 at 6:00 pm to hear how the county is working across a broad coalition of governments and jurisdictional boundaries to create proactive solutions for our communities. This presentation will inform you about the concerns related to sea level rise, what the county is doing to prepare for it, and how you can get involved. We'll also tell you about the Community Task Force (CTF), a group of community representatives who are helping to plan and conduct outreach efforts to raise public awareness on sea level rise.
