## *What!! Save \$300 On Your Annual Club Membership?*

Yes, it's true! You can receive a discount of up to 50% on your annual membership dues through our Watch Officer Discount program. This is how it works:

Every shift for which you volunteer to be a Watch Officer, up to a maximum of once a month, you will receive a \$25 credit toward your membership dues.

*So, for example...*

*You take 1 Watch Officer shift each quarter in 2017:*

*\$25 x 4 = \$100 off your annual dues*

*or*

*You take 1 Watch Officer shift a month in 2017:*

*\$25 x 12 = \$300 off your annual dues*



This was a recent update to our policy as a way to recognize our watch officers for the extra responsibility that you shoulder on behalf of the club.
