



News Flash: In early November, HMBYC Youth Sailing was awarded the Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Trophy from PICYA, the Pacific Inter-Club Yacht Association, for "having made the greatest advancement during the current year in promoting youth activity in yachting." PICYA represents clubs throughout the Bay Area and Northern California.

Congratulations to youth sailing director Des Cullen and lead instructor Jacob Abrahams, shown here accepting the trophy, as well as the entire instructor team! The Nimitz trophy, signed by Admiral Nimitz himself before it was first awarded in 1958, is PICYA's oldest award, among their most prestigious, and we are hugely proud of the youth sailing team for bringing it to the club.

Additionally, PICYA was sufficiently impressed by our program that they have further chosen to nominate us for the Garrett Horder Trophy, as the best youth sailing program on the entire West Coast. The Horder trophy is awarded by PCYA, the Pacific Coast Yacht Association, representing clubs and associations from Vancouver to San Diego, as well as Hawai'i. We should hear the outcome sometime in January...but simply being nominated is an honor.

Questions about Paddle Boards and SUPs

Q&A with Linda Galindo, **Membership Director at HMBYC**

As the new Membership Director I get questions from our newest members about how the SUPs and Kayak use works.

Here's the latest Q and A. Thanks to Amy Shefftz and Karina Lazorick our Paddle Committee for their responses.

Q: If I come to the club to use a kayak or SUP but do not have access to the paddles, what do I do?

A: Only members who have agreed to the policies and have been given access to the paddles are authorized to use the equipment. *Email Amy and Karina at paddle@hmbyc.org.* in advance, so when you get to the club you will have what you need to get out on the water. There is some chance you will get a quick email response on a weekend. Do give us a try, but please don't count on it.

Q; I keep hearing about a SUP and kayak "Policy". What's that about?

A: The SUP and Kayak 'Policy' is a list of rules and responsibilities members need to read thoroughly and commit to following in order to use the equipment.

Q: Who is allowed to give out the combination to the container for paddles?

A: Amy and Karina, the paddle team! Following this and all protocols is essential to keeping - and hopefully growing! - the paddle fleet. To maintain integrity in the system, please don't share the combination or ask another member for it.

or




You take 1 Watch Officer shift a month in 2017: ^{\$}25 x 12 – ^{\$}300 off your annual dues
