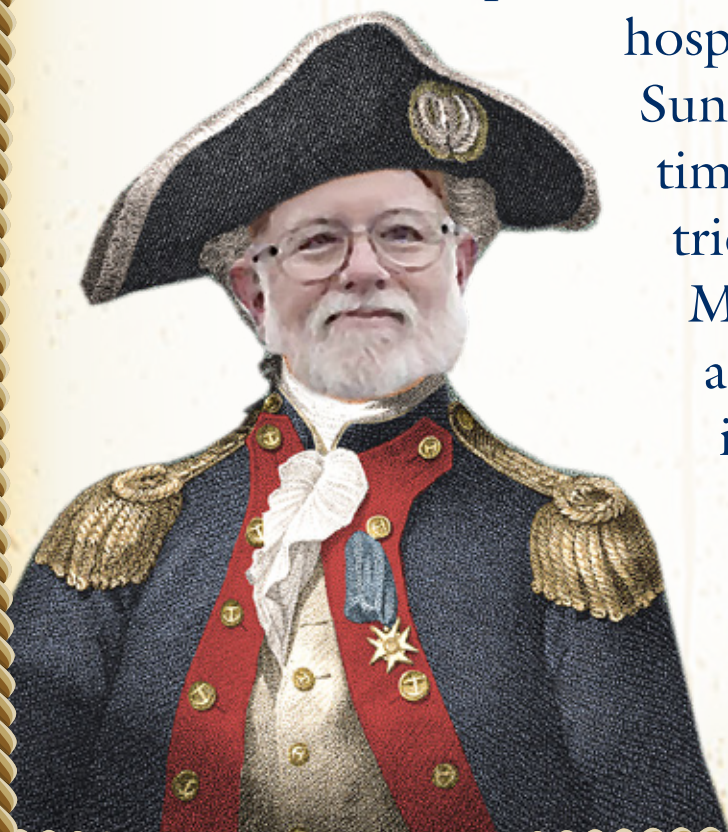
August 2018

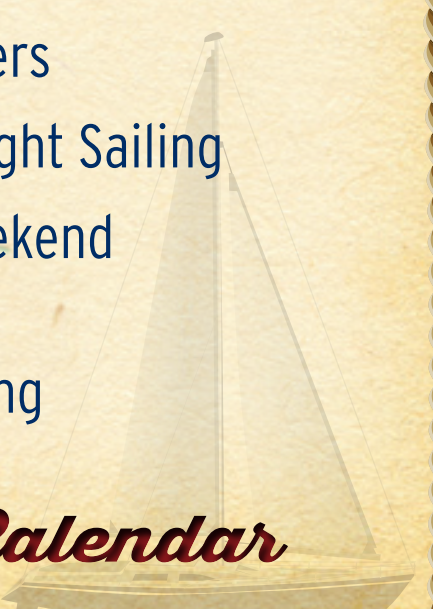

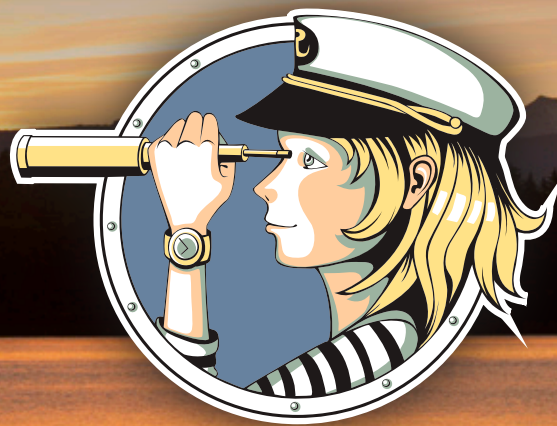


Bareboat Training in the San Juan's for Women Sailors
