Polynesian Voyaging Society Canoe Visits Half Moon Bay Yacht Club

The Half Moon Bay Yacht Club was honored to host the Polynesian voyaging canoe Hikianalia in September. As part of the Polynesian Voyaging Society's (PVS) outreach programs, she sailed over from Hawaii and is spending the next few months on the west coast of California until she sails home in December. They timed this voyage to attend the Global Climate Action Summit in San Francisco.

Hikianalia sailed across the Pacific Ocean using no sextant, no GPS, nothing but traditional Polynesian navigation wayfinding. These techniques were almost lost, since they were practiced by only very few people, but in the 1970's there was a cultural renaissance, led



by people who are now principals in PVS, and now there are people from all across Polynesia who practice wayfinding.

Their voyage across the Pacific Ocean took 23 days, with a 13 person crew. The captain of this voyage, as well as the principal navigator, were women, a first for PVS. They landed in Pillar Point harbor on 10 September, and HMBYC personnel greeted their arrival outside the harbor. With the HMBYC personnel was Nainoa Thompson, the president of PVS and the navigator on their first voyage from Hawaii to Tahiti in 1980 that proved that wayfinding can guide a boat across oceans. They spend several days at our yacht club decompressing and cleaning up the boat, sleeping in our Event Center. Then she went to San Francisco bay for formal events before starting her journey

south. She came back to Pillar Point harbor on 23 September for 3 days. During that time, to say "mahalo" (thank you) to us, her crew gave a presentation exclusively to HMBYC members on the Society; their canoes, Hokule'a and Hikianalia; and traditional Polynesian wayfinding. It was very well attended.



As part of the presentation they showed a video of their society and canoes.


