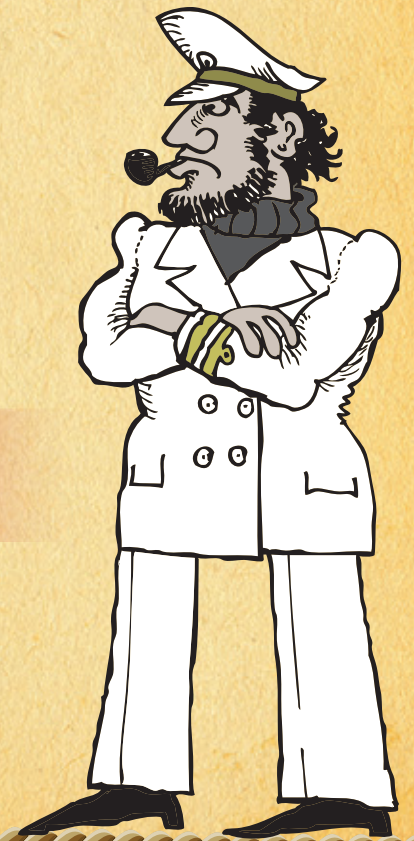
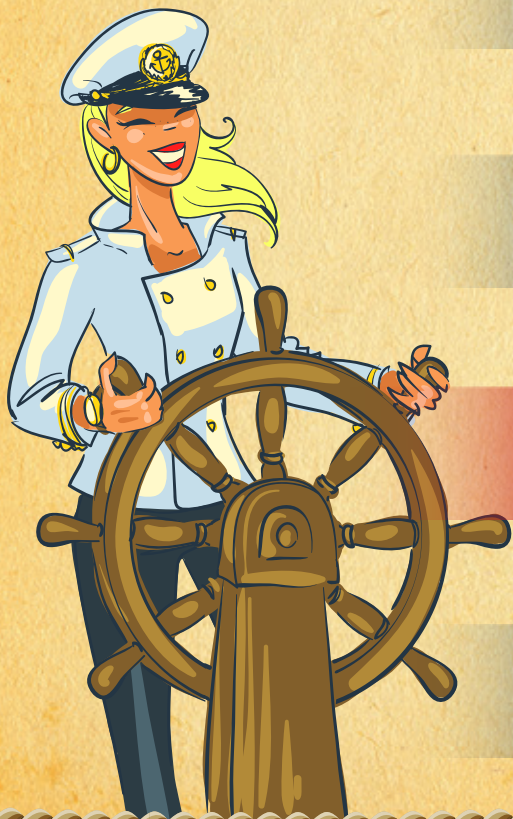
Please check in with the watch officer and let them know you are interested in sailing. The watch officer will then notify the skippers of your interest. Be sure to wear a PFD/life jacket!

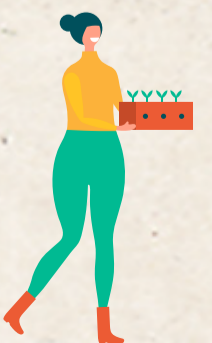
If you can paint ... the deck railing needs a coat of redwood stain. This will have to be brushed on carefully with drop-cloths to protect the deck.

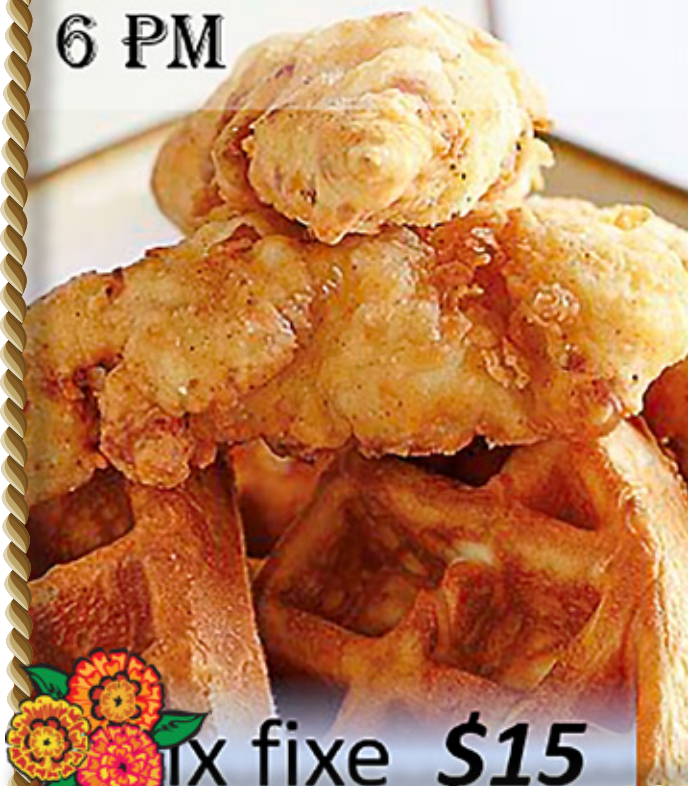

boats head out by mid-day



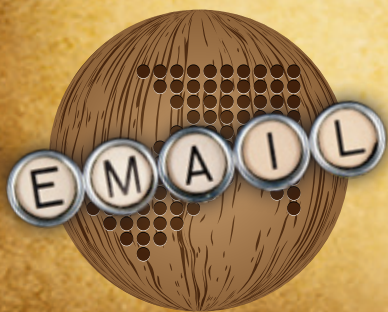

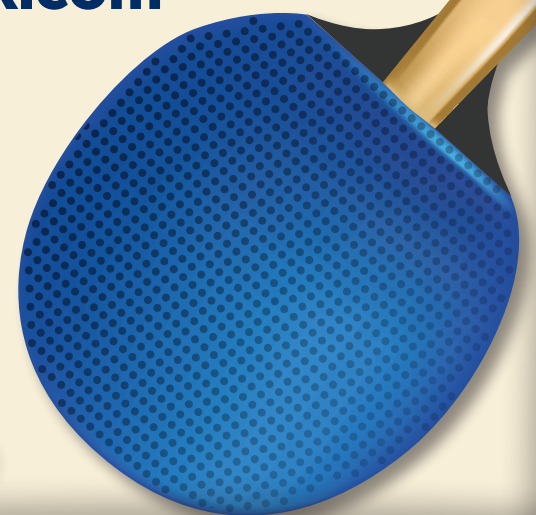
