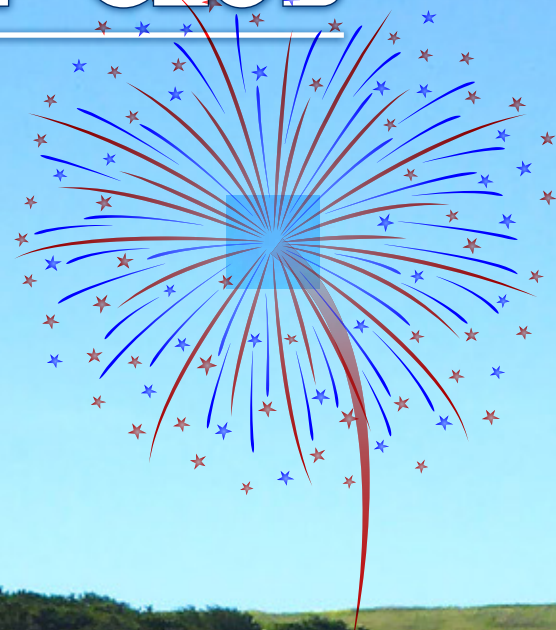

# Sunday Skippers

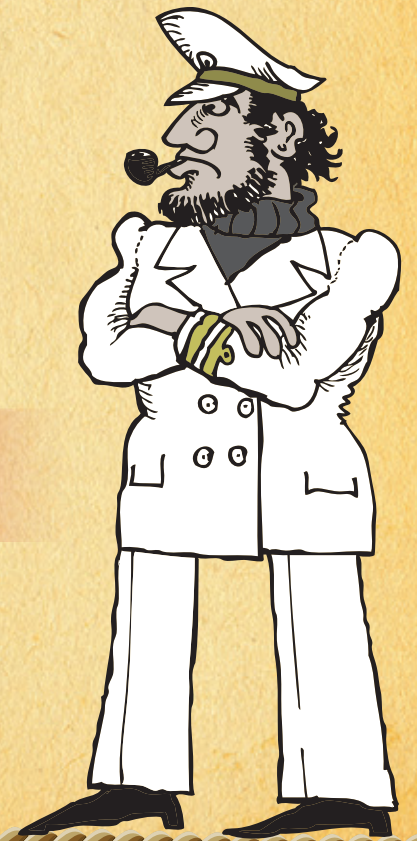
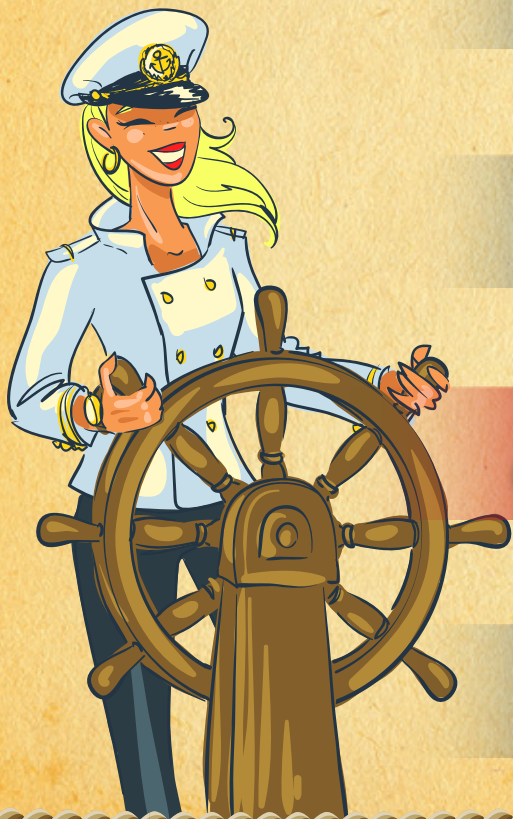

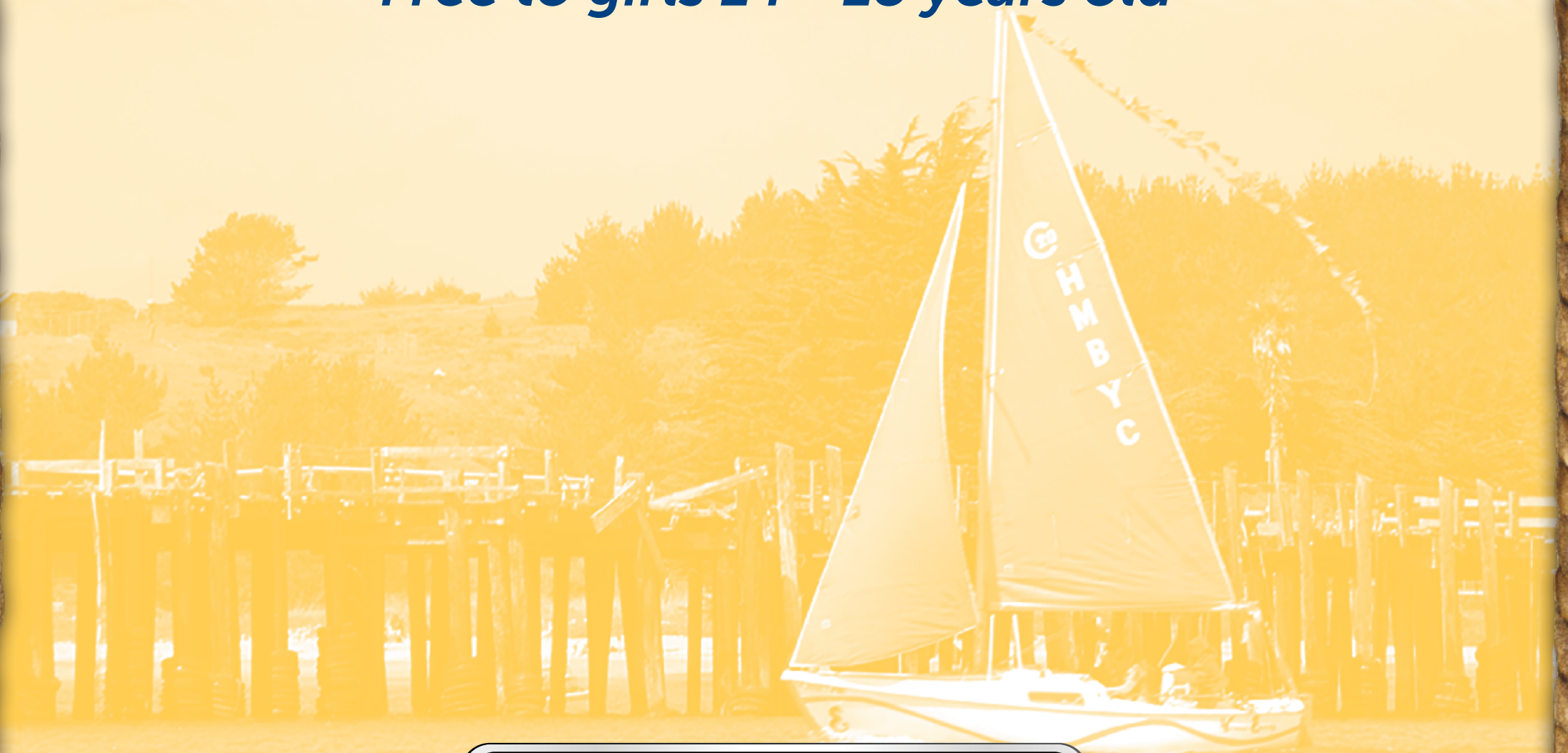
