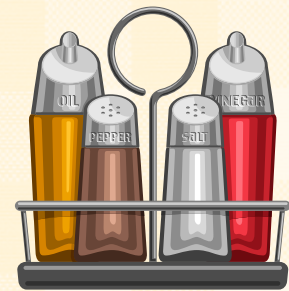

23rd Annual Wheelchair Regatta *Saturday September 28, 2019*



PICYA is the Pacific Inter Club Yacht Association – an organization of 108 Yacht Clubs across Northern California. It was formed in 1896 to promote inter-club communications, yachting activities and social interaction. Half Moon Bay Yacht Club is a member club and sends a Delegate to the monthly dinners & other activities. PICYA puts on events like Opening Day on S.F. Bay, two conferences a year that are open to all yacht club members and Wheelchair Regatta.

Wheelchair Regatta is coming up on Saturday Sept. 28 out of Encinal YC. This will be our 23rd Annual happening of this event for Veterans living institutional lives in VA Homes & Hospitals. Vets come from Yountville, both facilities in Menlo Park, Fremont, Palo Alto, Livermore & other facilities. We get 220-240 Vets coming to enjoy a boat ride up & down the Estuary, out on the Bay & even into McCovy Cove. After their boating they come back to Encinal where a Bar-B-Que & entertainment await them.

When they leave each Vet is personally thanked for their service & they are given a "goodie bag" filled with snacks, cookies & personal care products. **Here is where you come in.** The personal care products are donations from yacht club members and yacht clubs. Personal care products include shampoo & conditioner, deodorant, soap, body wash, tooth brushes & toothpaste, efferdent, hand lotion & combs. Hotel sized bottles work. Please unused/new items only.

A Donation Box has been left at the club to put these donations in. Think about a donation when going to the store and buy one of these items for a vet. A great place to shop is a 'Dollar Store". Donations of money to buy food & drinks for the event are muchly appreciated. **Make checks out to PICYA Foundation Wheelchair Regatta.** The PICYA Foundation will provide a tax deductible receipt.

Another way to help is to come to the event and help out. There are jobs that many hands make small work of.

A final way to participate is to come with your boat if you are able to take a few vets out for a ride. Please use the PICYA Web Site to sign up for this part.

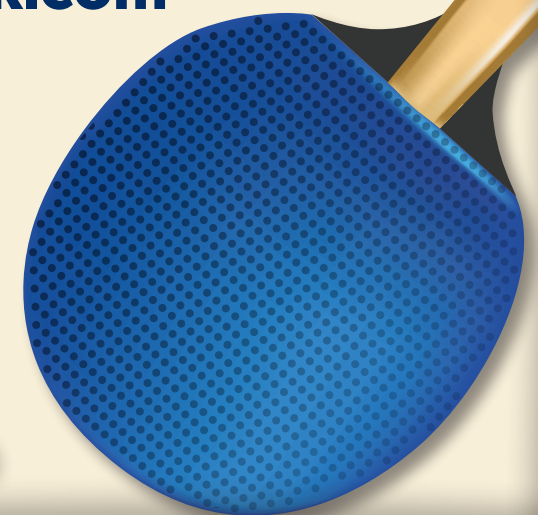
