Sunday Skippers

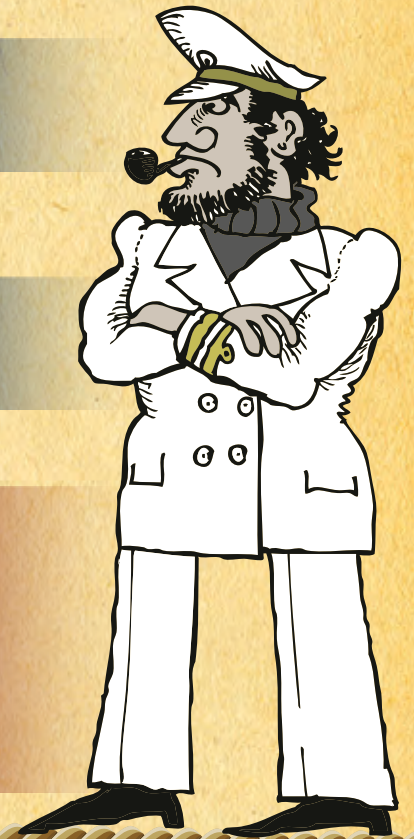
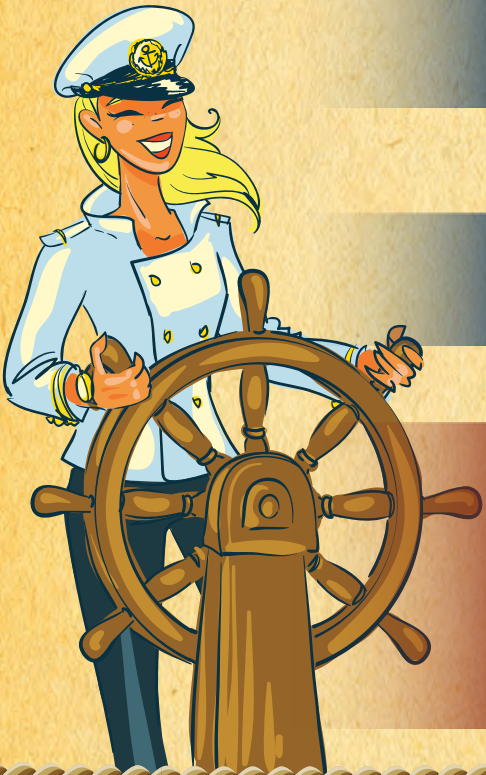
