

NOTICE OF RACE

SCHEDULE and LOCATION

- 1. The Regatta will be held on Saturday, 24 July 2021 in Pillar Point Harbor, Half Moon Bay, California.
- 2. Check-in will be 0900 to 1000. There will be a mandatory Skipper's Meeting at 1000 on the deck.
- 3. The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race is 1100. Five to seven races are scheduled, time permitting. No races will be started after 1500.

REGATTA RULES

- 4. The Organizing Authority for the Regatta is the Half Moon Bay Yacht Club ("HMBYC").
- 5. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the United States Sailing Association's *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (the "RRS").
- 6. For C15 competitors, the *Coronado 15 Association Class Rules* also apply. These rules are available <u>here</u>.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 7. The Regatta is open to boats of the Cal 20 one-design class.
- 8. At least three (3) boats must be entered to qualify for a class start. This number may be modified at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 9. Boat ownership is NOT required. We welcome ALL women for this event. HMBYC has a fleet of boats that we will be looking to fill with crew. So if you are interested, please contact us!



10. To enter, go to the HMBYC website http://www.hmbyc.org and click on the Calendar entry for the date of the Regatta, where there will be separate links for HMBYC members and non-members to register. Or fill out the attached form and bring it on the day of the Regatta.

FEES

11. For HMBYC members, there is no entry fee. This regatta is not open to non-members.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

12. The Sailing Instructions (SI) and this Notice of Race (NoR) will be available on the HMBYC website on the Sailing > Racing page, and also at check-in.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 13. Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk; see RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta.
- 14. All participants must agree to the Take the Tiller Women Sailing Regatta Waiver and Release of Liability. A signed copy must be emailed to the Race Committee (office@hmbyc.org) before the Regatta or delivered in person at the Regatta. The form is found here.

- 15. If a competitor thinks she has been exposed to COVID-19 or has, within the past 14 days, been in a group without exercising proper social distancing and wearing masks, then **DO NOT ATTEND** this Regatta.
- 16. All participants must adhere to the California and San Mateo County COVID restrictions. Details will be given in the Sailing Instructions.
