Do Your Fair Share

As you know we are an all volunteer club. Please try your hardest not to create work for other volunteers by cleaning up after yourselves. If you borrow a PFD from the sailing locker, please return it on a hanger to the rack. If you used club dishes, please wash them. If you are enjoying a drink on the deck, please bus your glassware to a bus tray, or the bar. If you use the ferry, please send it back out to the dock when you are done. If you borrow tools from the tool shed, please return them.

And a reminder about three very important club policies:

- Do not bring any outside alcoholic beverages to the club. We are only allowed to consume alcohol purchased from the club on club property.
 Please do not take drinks off of our property.
- Children must be directly supervised by a parent or guardian at all times.
- Pets, most commonly dogs, must be kept from annoying other members.

Dues increasing January 1, 2022

With the support of its members, HMBYC is surviving the challenges of the pandemic and continues to offer social and recreation opportunities for members. Dues have not been increased for years, despite increased costs and significantly reduced revenue due to all the COVID closures of the past year and a half. In addition, we haven't been able to open the Club during some weekend days due to a lack of Watch Officers. We need a more reliable way to ensure the Club can be open during its posted hours.

With this in mind, your Board voted to increase the membership initiation fee from \$500 to \$800. We have not increased the initiation fee for some time and this will have no impact on existing members.

Further, your Board voted to increase monthly dues from \$60 per month to \$100 per month. However, if you set up your member charge account in our bookkeeping system, you will receive a monthly discount on dues of \$25 bringing your dues down to \$75 (up from \$60). The utilization of these additional fees will support hiring an additional staff person that will be responsible for having the Club open consistently on the weekends. These fees will also help pay for more staff for our Youth Sailing Program and help upgrade our boat fleets and facilities, and will allow us to consider adding other services to enhance your member experience."

The new fee schedule will be effective January 1, 2022.
