Dues increasing January 1, 2022

With the support of its members, HMBYC is surviving the challenges of the pandemic and continues to offer social and recreation opportunities for members. Dues have not been increased for years, despite increased costs and significantly reduced revenue due to all the COVID closures of the past year and a half. In addition, we haven't been able to open the Club during some weekend days due to a lack of Watch Officers. We need a more reliable way to ensure the Club can be open during its posted hours.

With this in mind, your Board voted to increase the membership initiation fee from \$500 to \$800. We have not increased the initiation fee for some time and this will have no impact on existing members.

Further, your Board voted to increase monthly dues from \$60 per month to \$100 per month. However, if you set up your member charge account in our bookkeeping system (see next article) or pay annually, you will receive a monthly discount on dues of \$25 bringing your dues down to \$75 (up from \$60). 
The utilization of these additional fees will support hiring an additional staff person that will be responsible for having the Club open consistently on the weekends. These fees will also help pay for more staff for our Youth Sailing Program and help upgrade our boat fleets and facilities, and will allow us to consider adding other services to enhance your member experience."


The new fee schedule will be effective January 1, 2022.

Setting Up Member Auto-Payments

To set up autopayments, login and navigate to 'My Club'. Then:





After clicking on "Schedule a future or recurring payment":

Make sure you have selected Statement Balance as the Payment amount.

Schedule a Monthly payment on set day of the month. Choose a date after the 10th of the month.

Setting up recurring monthly payments for your full statement balance allows you to charge drinks to your member account and gives you a \$25 discount on your monthly dues starting in January when dues increase to \$100 per month. With the discount you will pay only \$75 per month.
