#### **New Access System**

Nexkey has gone out of business. We have installed a new access system that works with an app called Brivo Mobile Pass. You should have received an email from Brivo inviting you to install the app and add your mobile pass to your app. Unfortunately, there was only a three day window for installation. If you have not already set yourself up you will need to contact vicecommodore@hmbyc.org or facilitiesmanager@hmbyc.org and we will resend the invitation to you. You will then first download the Brivo Mobile Pass app and set up your own account with any username & password you like. Then return to the email and add your mobile pass to your app. You will then be able to open the

Bar Door, Event Center Front Door and Event Center Back Door anytime you wish.

#### **Important Reminders**

As you know we are an all volunteer club. Please try your hardest not to create work for other volunteers by cleaning up after yourselves. If you borrow a PFD from the sailing locker, please return it on a hanger to the rack. If you used club dishes, please wash them. If you are enjoying a drink on the deck, please bus your glassware to a bus tray, or the bar. If you use the ferry, please send it back out to the dock when you are done.
