NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

1. The Organizing Authority for the Regatta is the Half Moon Bay Yacht Club (“HMBYC”).
2. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in [The Racing Rules of Sailing](#) (the “RRS”) and the [US Sailing Prescriptions](#).

COMMUNICATION

3. The *Official Regatta Notice Board* is on the HMBYC [website](#) on the *Sailing > Racing* page, where may be found this Notice of Race (NoR), the Sailing Instructions (SI), and any amendments.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4. The Regatta is open to boats of the Cal 20 one-design class.
5. There must be at least three (3) boats entered to qualify for a start. This number may be modified at the discretion of the Race Committee.
6. Boats may enter the Regatta by registering online; go to the HMBYC [website](#) and click on the Calendar entry for the Regatta.



FEES

7. The fee to enter the regatta is \$10 per boat.

SCHEDULE

8. There will be a Skipper's Meeting at 1000 on the HMBYC deck. All sailors racing are encouraged to attend.

9. The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race is 1100. Five to seven races are scheduled, time permitting. No races will be started after 1500.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

10. Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk; see *RRS Rule 3, Decision to Race*. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta.

11. All participants must agree to the *Commodore's Regatta Waiver and Release of Liability*. A signed copy must be emailed to the Club Steward (office@hmbyc.org) before the Regatta or delivered in person at the Regatta. The form is found [here](#).
