Adult Sailing Classes

This year we are offering 3 levels of adult sailing classes from April to September. Check the calendar to sign up!

Adult Beginning Class

This two-day course provides an introduction to sailing the club's Cal 20 keelboats. Our focus is safety, fun, and learning. Your time will be split between the classroom and on the water. In the classroom, as a small group of 12, we will discuss theory and learn terminology. On the water teams of 3 will be paired with an instructor. You will learn to rig the boats, practice sailing within Princeton Harbor, and return safely to put the toys away. Although we use US Sailing's teaching materials, this is not a US Sailing accredited program. Nor does this class qualify you to sail the club's boats independently. However, this course is a great gateway to further sailing adventures.

Adult Intermediate Sailing Class

This one-day course hopes to be many things to many people. Maybe you have a significant sailing resume, but you are new to the club and want to know the ins and outs of becoming a skipper authorized to use the Cal 20s on your own. Maybe you have been a club member for some time and could use more formal instruction to build your confidence. We want to help you improve your sailing skills starting from wherever you are.


